Some of the key vCISO activities include:

-  Information security planning and management

-  Evaluation of 3rd parties and their access to an organisation's systems and data
-  Management of audits by regulators or customers

Why a vCISO?

The rise in cyberattacks, data breaches and attack sophistication highlights the requirement to put a comprehensive set of controls and technologies in place, which becomes an impossible task without a driven information security programme. Implementing a vCISO allows organisations to quickly fill the CISO role and capitalise on readily available experience.
-  CISOs are an expensive hire. While almost every organisation needs a CISO, not all of them can afford one. A vCISO allows organisations to avoid the expense of employing one in-house, only paying for the services and time used.
-  vCISOs can be more experienced. A vCISO has implemented information security programmes and is working with many clients across various set of industries and sizes, giving them a broad range of expertise, all of which that can be applied to your business right away.
-  A vCISO is a consumption-based option, based on an agreed scope of work, so you only pay for what you need.
